A. <u>PURPOSE:</u> To establish basic guidelines for the obtaining maintenance, and monitoring of the state crime statistics publications.

## B. POLICY:

- 1. Each crime reporting agency is required to submit UCR data monthly to the central repository, pursuant to NRS 179A.075.
- 2. Data received from each agency is verified, entered into the central repository, translated and submitted to the FBI.
- 3. All data received is aggregated on a quarterly basis. A tracking sheet of monthly agency submissions will be maintained.
- 4. Data will be published on the department publicity website, <a href="www.NVCrimeMapping.com">www.NVCrimeMapping.com</a>, every six months. A summary of quarterly agency submissions will be published concurrently.
- 5. Published semiannual data tables will provide a brief overview of current trends in violent and property crimes, domestic violence offenses, and elderly abuse.
- 6. Aggregated data will be published on <a href="http://rccd.nv.gov/About/UCR/Crime-In-Nevada/">http://rccd.nv.gov/About/UCR/Crime-In-Nevada/</a>, once per year. This annual report is a comprehensive, graphical representation of the crime in Nevada.
- 7. Data will be published online by the following dates each year.
  - i. Quarter I & II (January June): September 1
  - ii. Quarter III & IV (July December): March 1
  - iii. Crime-In Nevada Annual Report (January December): July 1st
